

Sixth Form Dress Code

- Collared shirt or polo Shirt
- T-shirt using guidance below
- Smart “office style” blouse or top. Shoulders and midriff must be covered.
- Tops for warmer weather can be sleeveless provided the strap covers the majority of the shoulder and no bra strap is on show.
- T-shirt using guidance below
- Smart trousers, jeans or shorts (shorts are only permitted during the summer term and must be dress shorts e.g. either trouser or jean material, no sports shorts)
- Thick leggings (must be worn with a long top)
- Skirts, dresses and shorts – knee length (shorts are only permitted during the summer term and must be dress shorts e.g. either trouser or jean material)
- Smart jacket, cardigan or jumper
- Footwear should be appropriate and provide adequate protection.

Dress Code Guidance

- Logos should be unobtrusive
- No ripped fabric in any clothes
- No extremes of hair colour or fashion
- No cargo trousers, shorts or jogging bottoms
- No hats worn in-doors
