TERM 1	What are inferential stats?
	The final part of your research method journey is to understand how and when to use the common tests psychologists uses to infer a significant causal relationship.
TERM 2	What are the psychological explanations of Gender development?
	You will be applying your psychology knowledge base to explain gender development from androgyny to biological theories, from experiments to case studies.
TERM 3	What are the psychological explanations of Gender development?
	This term will continue with gender development, looking mainly at Gender Identity Disorder, and recapping the unit by comparing and contrasting theories.
TERM 4	What are the psychological explanations for criminal behaviour?
	During this unit, we will be exploring the psychology of the criminal and their behaviour. Focusing on the psychological footprint left at a crime scene, to looking at the effects of custody and reoffending, you may need to put your CSI skills to the test.
TERM 5	How do I get the most from the exam?
	This term will prepare you for the requirements of the three exams. Revision strategies, exam techniques and model answers will be explored during this term.
