

# Y8 ROADMAP - ART

**Subject Aim:** In year 7 you spent time learning about the formal elements of Art. Year 8 Art takes your basic skills and shows you how to apply them in different ways. You will learn how different artists use the rules of Art to create a range of different artworks using different materials and processes.

## What are the rules of perspective?

In this project you will learn how artists and designers create space and depth in their work. You will develop your skills within painting and tonal shading to make things appear like they have depth. You will learn all about one point perspective drawing and how this can be used to draw different scenes such as interiors and exteriors. You will explore how perspective is used within animation and video game design, to create your own personal outcome.

## What is portraiture and how have artists responded to this starting point?

In this project you will explore the work of a range of artists who have investigated the theme of portraiture. You will learn how to use different 2D materials and techniques to learn about their work and develop your skills in recording. You will be shown how to draw a portrait through a series of rules and measurements to make you work accurate. You will explore how different artists have used this theme in their own work.

## Can Art be made from the everyday?

Artists are always looking for new themes and ideas for their work. After the second world war a group of artists became interested in using the everyday world as the starting point for their art. Before this Art had been about traditional theme such as portraits and landscapes. This group of artists wanted their art to be for everyone and started to look at everyday things such as food and mass produced items. In this project you will investigate their work and will learn how to use 3D materials and processes to make your very own food sculptures.

- Your teacher will set you independent learning tasks which involve you bringing things in to help prepare you for the lesson such as source images or research.
