How has Romanticism influenced the Literary Tradition?

What is the Gothic tradition and how has it shaped Literature?

You will study the Lady of Shalott by Tennyson and research Arthurian legends. You will learn how to analyse language carefully to find hidden meanings. You will read an abridged version of "Wuthering Heights" and explore characterization and plotting through the lens of the Gothic tradition.

How do writers use persuasive language to encourage people to travel?

You will read a range of travel texts, including media texts , brochures and literary travel writing. You will explore a range of different persuasive techniques, and then use those techniques to write in a wide range of different styles, so that you have the ability to use language to 8inform, persuade and entertain a target audience.

How do writers use the supernatural to engage their readers?

You will study Arthur Miller's classic play "The Crucible" and explore the historical and social context behind the play. You will consider how the author uses the historical context to comment on his contemporary society. You will also explore subtle characterization and sophisticated dramatic techniques used by writers

How do writers use monsters as metaphors?

You will study" The Tempest" by William Shakespeare and how Shakespeare uses monsters and supernatural creatures as metaphors to comment on society. You will explore the complex language of Shakespeare and develop your skills of Speaking and Listening through role play and putting characters on trial.
