## Subject Aim:

To study Natural Hazards caused by the weather and tectonic processes.

TERM 1

## What hazards are there in the UK?

What is a natural hazard? Which do we experience in the UK? You will study an example of a hazard in the UK.

## Tropical storms

You will learn how they are formed and where in the world experiences tropical storms. You will learn a case study.

TERM 2

## Climate change –what are the causes, impacts and responses?

You will learn about the features of a volcano and why people live near them. You will study what can happen when a volcano erupts.

TERM 5

## China –the emerging superpower

You will learn how China has increased their wealth and power. How has a fishing village in China become a powerhouse in the Chinese economy?

## How can we compare the levels of development between countries and close the gap?

You will create and play top trumps cards to learn how indicators of development can be used to compare countries? You learn how Fairtrade can help close the gap.
