## Subject Aim:

**What is GCSE Music and how can I start to appraise, perform and compose with an understanding of the marking scheme?**

Autumn Term	<b>Forms &amp; Devices</b> You will revisit terminology for different musical structures with a focus on Baroque, Classical and Romantic periods and how these link with the musical elements. 	<b>Music for Ensemble</b> In this unit, you will be looking at different textures and cover new styles not covered in Year 10. You will begin your first composition which makes up 15% of the course. You will complete		
Spring Term	<b>Ensemble Recording</b> You will be completing your ensemble recording which is 15% of your final grade. All coursework needs to be handed in this term (2 compositions, 2 performances).		
	<b>Film Music</b> In this unit you will be considering special effects, minimalist techniques, chromatic and extended harmonic devices used in film music.
