Subject Aim:

What is Music and how can I start to appraise, perform and compose?

Autumn Term	<h3>Intro to Music</h3> <p>In this unit you will look at the elements of music. These are fundamental to all aspects of music and throughout your music journey. We begin to look at keyboard skills and basic notation.</p>	<h4>ASSESSMENT</h4> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Every lesson will start with a listening task to develop your understanding of the elements of music.• At the end of each unit you will perform your rehearsed piece and evaluate other groups.• You will set yourself personal targets which will help guide you in your next unit.
	<h3>The Voice</h3> <p>In this unit, you will be looking at how the voice is used and how to develop some basic singing skills. You will create your own vocal composition in groups.</p>	
Spring Term	<h3>Keyboard Skills</h3> <p>In this unit, you are further developing your keyboard skills learnt in Term 1. You will start to read notation and complete a performance on the keyboard.</p>	<h4>ENRICHMENT</h4> <p>During the Autumn term we will be auditioning, rehearsing and finally performing our whole school show! Everyone who auditions gets a part! Personal practice for working on your own or in small groups is available on a Wednesday and Thursday lunchtime in music.</p>
	<h3>NK's Got Talent!</h3> <p>In this unit you will be working on a performance towards a talent show. You will set targets and develop your performance throughout the term.</p>	
Summer Term	<h3>Music Through Time</h3> <p>In this unit you will be considering how music has been used through the years and how it has evolved to become music of today. You will also consider how music is used as a tool for mental health.</p>	
	<h3>Reggae</h3> <p>In this unit you will be looking at Caribbean Music and what the key features of Reggae are. You will create a class Reggae band.</p>
