Autumn Term	<h3>Music Through Time</h3> <p>In this unit you will be considering how music has been used through the years and how it has evolved to become music of today. 	<h3>Fusions</h3> <p>In this unit you will be continuing with the work started in Term 1 and creating a fusion of your chosen piece on Reaper.</p>		
Spring Term	<h3>NK's Got Talent!</h3> <p>In this unit you will be working on a performance towards a talent show. You will set targets and develop your performance throughout the term.</p>		INDEPENDENT LEARNING
	<h3>The Blues</h3> <p>In this unit you will be looking at how the Blues music has developed and influenced modern music. You will be performing your own compositions on keyboards/guitars</p>		
Summer Term	<h3>Modern Music Making</h3> <p>In this unit you will be using Reaper and creating a remix of a modern song. You will be considering how music writing has changed over time and what modern composers are using.</p>	ENRICHMENT	
	<h3>Film Music</h3> <p>In this unit you will be considering the importance of film and creating your own piece of music to represent a short film using Reaper.</p>
