## Subject Aim:

- To learn about the world that we live in.
- To enable students to learn a range geographical skills.
- To be able to discuss, compare, identify and judge different aspects of geographical processes and human activities and the impacts they have.

TERM 1

## What issues with tectonic hazards?

You will learn about the global distribution of tectonic hazards and the different impacts and preparation in HIC's and LIC's.

TERM 2

## Why are rainforests valuable?

You will learn about location and climate and how plants and animals adapt to that environment. You will study deforestation, the causes, impacts and ways to reduce it.

TERM 3

## What is resource management?

You will learn about food, water and energy in the UK. You will then focus on one of these on a global scale and in greater depth.

TERM 4

## How do rivers work?

You will learn how and why a river changes from it's source to its mouth. You will focus on flooding in terms of causes, impacts and management.

TERM 5

## What issues in LIC Cities?

We will use a case study to look at the challenges and opportunities in a city in a low income country.

TERM 6

## What Is The Economic Change In The UK?

You will learn about deindustrialisation and the North/South divide. You will study the strategies to close the gap between the North and South.
