

# Y8 ROADMAP – Geography

## Subject Aim:

- To learn about population structure and change. To look at migration issues. To identify the opportunities and challenges cities face.
- To learn about the world of work and question whether the earth will run out of natural resources.
- To study coastal landforms and erosion and to look at weather and climate, with a focus on the UK and tropical storms.

TERM 1

## Where do people live in the world?

You will learn about population structure and change. We will question whether a government can and should control population size. We will consider migration issues and the impacts it has.

TERM 2

## What issues do urban areas have?

You will learn about the opportunities and challenges of cities and how they can be regenerated and made more sustainable.

TERM 3

## What is the world of work like?

You will learn about types of employment and about how the UK trades with the rest of the world. You will consider why industries locate where they do.

TERM 4

## Why is the coast like this?

You will learn about key coastal landforms and how they are created. You will also learn about coastal erosion and the conflicts it can lead to.

TERM 5

## Will we run out of natural resources?

We will question whether the earth will run out of natural resources. The focus will be on energy resources and the issue of renewable and non-renewable sources.

TERM 6

## What is weather and climate?

You will learn about the weather and climate of the UK. We will look at the impacts of an extreme weather event in the UK.

- You will do some self assessed work.
