New streamlined system for setting homework:

This academic year, North Kesteven Academy are excited to be moving to a new streamlined system for setting homework which will help our students to be more organised as well as provide them with clear accessible instructions and support.

All of our teachers will now set homework using the *Go4Schools* platform. When setting homework on *Go4Schools* they will provide students with a title, clear instructions, guidance on time and links to any additional resources. Students will then be able to view this by logging into their own personal *Go4Schools* account and once completed select 'done' to log their completion.

Students will be shown how to access their *Go4Schools* accounts in school to ensure that staff can assist with any troubleshooting that is required. Students will also be able to access further troubleshooting clinics on a daily basis at lunchtime in C1 all of next week. **The attached instructions provide clear guidance to ensure that your child can log in to their *Go4Schools* account. This can be done on any device that uses an internet browser and will use the same credentials (username and password) which they use to log on to a computer in school. We would be grateful if you would support your child to both access and familiarise themselves with this.**

As parents/carers, you will be able to monitor this through your child's *Go4Schools* account and support them to develop their independent learning skills. Our intention is to provide clarity and transparency so that our children can benefit from these vital opportunities to enhance their academic studies through developing and deepening their knowledge and understanding.

We apologise for the delay in not getting this information to you sooner and thank you for your patience and understanding. As I am sure you will appreciate, with any new system there are always technical issues and we wanted to be absolutely sure that our use of *Go4Schools* was fully functioning before you received this communication.
